The Fond Blanc Foundation is an organization that supports an orphanage of 54 children in the small, mountainous community of Fond Blanc, Haiti. The foundation was started by Alison Praisewater and Andrew Attwell after the 2010 earthquake destroyed an orphanage run by community leader Pastor Jean Claude.

Even with the help of various organizations, the rebuilding on the orphanage was only the beginning. These children lack proper nutrition, educational opportunities, and basic care. The foundation covers all costs associated with the orphanage - food, water, education, health and general care - and their costs are much higher than most traditional sponsorship programs. They need your help to continue their efforts of enriching meals with nutritional value, providing sanitary food and water to members of the community, preventing and treating the various health conditions prevalent among the children, and providing a basic educational structure.
